## GOOGLE Safe Search Settings

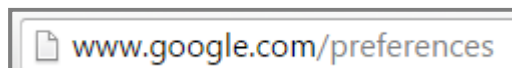
PLEASE NOTE:

You need to have a gmail account to turn on Google SafeSearch.

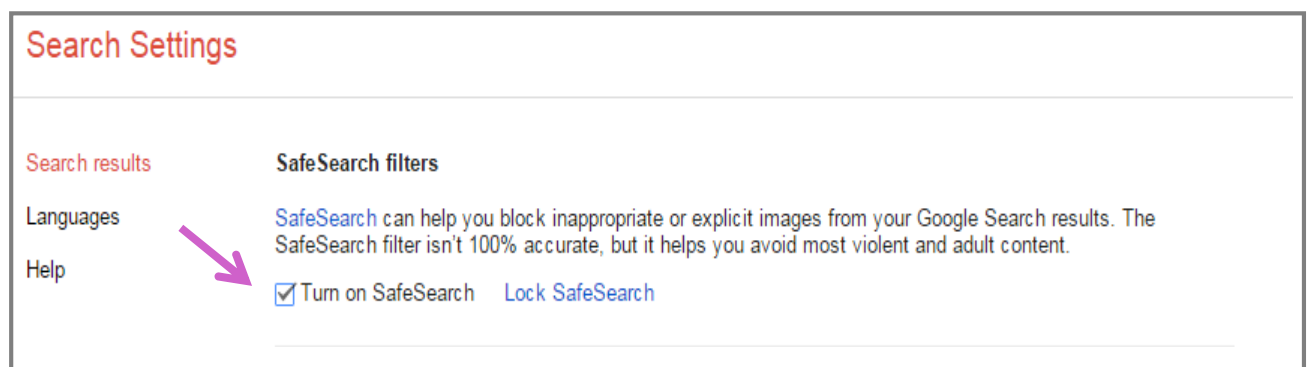
The following instructions are for Laptop and Desktop Computers. Mobile Device instructions are below them.

1 Sign into your gmail account

2 In the address bar of your browser, type in [www.google.com/preferences](http://www.google.com/preferences) and press enter



3 Place a tick in the box next to Turn on SafeSearch


