PLEASE NOTE:


You need to have a gmail account to turn on Google SafeSearch.

The following instructions are for Laptop and Desktop Computers. Mobile Device instructions are below them.

- 1 Sign into your gmail account
- In the address bar of your browser, type in www.google.com/preferences and press enter



Place a tick in the box next to Turn on SafeSearch






- 4 Click on Lock SafeSearch
- You will be prompted to enter your gmail account password




- Type in your password and press Sign in
- 7 Click on LockSearch





The coloured balls on the top right of the screen indicate that Google SafeSearch has been activated.




9 You can now close the tab on the browser




- 1 Go to Google
- 2 Scroll down and select Settings






