## How to Review Apps & Online Games

A great place to start for reviewing apps is the App Store or Google Play. Both will guide you on the recommended age a child should be to have an account and it will also give you information around the content. This will include things like Swearing, Violence, Nudity and references to drugs and alcohol.

The information that is not included is around some of the functionality of the app and available privacy settings.



Now it's time to do a little research of your own.

Firstly, I recommend that you visit [commonsensemedia.org](https://www.commonsensemedia.org) and use their search function to search for the app or online game you are interested in.

Commonsense Media will outline the age and content for the app as well as give you an explanation on what the game is about. They include reviews from other parents whose children have played the game and reviews from the children themselves. I highly recommend that you read the parents reviews. This is where you discover things about the app that are not necessarily documented anywhere else.

It doesn't hurt to 'google' reviews of the app either. You can generate further parental reviews. Also be on the lookout for functionality within the app such as chat and the privacy settings.
